 - B. **Resolution No. 25-75: Request for Municipal Council Approval to Amend Resolution No. 25-55 Regarding Appointments to Boards, Commissions, and Committees**
To amend Resolution No. 25-55 of the Municipal Council of Norristown regarding appointments to the Municipal Citizen Boards and Committees. This amendment updates the membership of the Blighted Property Removal Committee by removing Amber Curnew and appointing Alvina Hamme to serve in her place.
 - C. **Resolution No. 25-76: Request for Municipal Council Approval of Minor Construction and Furnishings for Additional Workspaces in the Code, Planning, and Police Departments for a Total Cost of \$93,236.14**
To authorize minor construction and the purchase of furnishings to create additional workspaces for the Code Department, Planning Department, and Police Department. This expansion is necessary to address current space limitations and to improve efficiency for municipal staff. Additionally, relocating a Public Works employee to the Code/Planning area for permitting purposes will bring the Municipality into compliance with ADA accessibility requirements.

pruning, removal of dead trees and weight reduction along Main Street, Marshall Street and DeKalb Street.

NORRISTOWN BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT - FUNDED BY ARPA FUNDS

Regarding the (3) major thoroughfares within Norristown Borough, we will prune the existing trees to maintain and promote proper arboricultural practice. The pruning would consist of removal of dead branches, structural thinning throughout the canopies of the trees, weight reduction and building clearance where necessary, and proper head clearance for the rights-of-way which would include both the streets and the sidewalks. The Certified Arborist will determine which trees shall have to be removed.

C. Resolution No. 25-72: Council to approve an award in the amount of \$463,500 (COSTARS Price) to R Smith Paving Contractors (COSTARS #014-E23-334) for the paving and stamping of intersections on Main Street.

Proposal - Prevailing Wage

A. Job Specifications:

1. Paving:

- a. Mill/cut/excavate asphalt 2”.
- b. Clean and haul away debris.
- c. Supply and install 2” -9.5mm hot asphalt top.

2. Stamping:

- a. Infrared heat asphalt.
- b. Imprint pattern (diagonal herringbone) with border.
- c. Apply HD Colorpave acrylic (terra cotta).

B. Areas:

1. Main Street approximately 13,967 sq.ft. (Stamp entire junction) Areas include the following
 - a. Main Street and Barbadoes St
 - b. Main Street and Cherry Street
 - c. Main Street and DeKalb Street
 - d. Main Street and Green St
 - e. Main Street and Arch Street
 - f. Main Street and Walnut Street

D. Resolution No. 25-73: Council to approve the contract awarded to Signarama Montco (CoStars 032-E24-087) in the amount of \$398,853.08 (CoStars Price) for work that will include replacement and installation of signs, street ID's, wrapping of Big Belly cans, traffic signal boxes, painting of streetlight poles and other miscellaneous.
