PROSOV, LLC is requesting a zoning text change to the Multifamily Residential district to actualize the development plan presented to Council at the May 19, 2021 Council workshop. The developer is proposing: a 4 (four) story elevator apartment building (POD) with 192 units and 267 parking spaces, 2.5 story 89 Townhouses (rental) with 89 parking spaces, 2, 3, 4 story multiplex (for sale) 90 units with 212 parking spaces. There are 568 parking spaces overall for the development.
