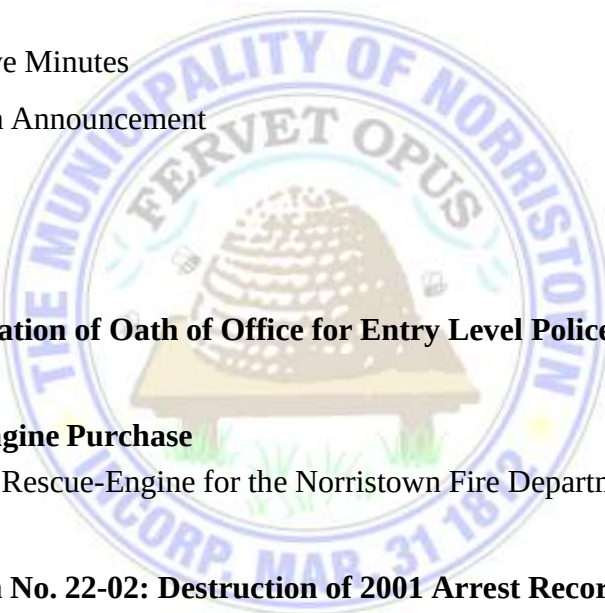

Request approval for an advance of general funds in the amount of \$21,330 to remit to HUD for expended 2015 Community Development Block Grant administration funds

which exceeded the 20% expenditure cap for administrative costs for the given grant year. The advance of general funds will be reimbursed with funds from the 2021 CDBG administration budget. Once reprogrammed, HUD will re-credit the Municipality's 2015 grant year for the full reimbursement amount of \$21,330. These funds will then be allocated to the Municipality's 2022 Section 108 Loan Repayment program for disbursement.
